Hello Family,

So today I have spent a great deal of time speaking to a few of you about your thoughts and opinions. It's come to my attention that out of 11 siblings, we will not be able to make everyone happy.

I understand this is an extremely tense, frustrating, overwhelming and stressful time for everyone. But I hope that we can all rise above it and try to pull together in support of one another.

Since there has been a lot of discussion about finances, I am going to lay it all out there. There are some who can afford more than others, that is no surprise. One has agreed to cover 50% of the cost, Bac Phoung and Chi both have opted out of paying. So the burden then lies with the other eight siblings.

I had to recalculate the totals to include the monk and third party casket. I had to divide the 50% total by eight. Next to each name, please be honest and just put down what you can realistically afford. This way I have a clearer financial picture.

Now I don't want to get into anyone's financial situation, but I know what the tension is like for each side. Know that if you can't handle your part - you then put the burden on other family members to cover the slack. So if you can't afford the full cost, then perhaps you can offer to make payments or at least contribute a portion of the cost. That is just my suggestion. Everyone is entitled to how they feel about the financial situation, whether you can afford it or not. But to keep things going smoothly, I would love it if we could just be considerate of one another, and try to be as cordial and considerate about

everyone's situation. Please also do not assume whether someone can or cannot make up the slack. I think that is causing some tensions.

I have taken the liberty to cover the names of those I have already spoken to, and know that they can handle their part. Please fill in the chart and send it back to me. Thank you

1) Option A - \$11,000 mortuary package (now includes cost of monk)

\$5500 Michael Wyn

\$688 per family x 8

2) Option B - \$10,000 (casket and monk now included in over all price)

\$5500 goes to HARD COST of the funeral, things we cannot get out of.  
\$1390 (casket, taxes, and cheapest - compared to \$3600 at the mortuary)  
\$999 head marker (the best price I could find - this is going through the mortuary, everywhere else was \$1200+)  
\$783 (casket vault, what the casket will go in when buried. The cheapest I also found.  
\$600 (3 bouquets of flowers roughly about \$200 each)  
\$700 (Monk)
